SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

- Selection will be made by the Montana 4-H Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee. Recipients will be notified in May.
- If you are awarded a scholarship, In order for your scholarship payment to be made, you must complete your first semester of college and send an unofficial transcript showing GPA and proof of enrollment for a second semester. After the Montana 4-H Foundation receives this information showing the GPA requirements for your scholarship are met, the scholarship payment will be sent to your Financial Aid Office.
- Almost all scholarships require specific GPA requirements to be met before funds are distributed. Please see specific details on the website listed above. If the GPA requirements are not met, the scholarship will be awarded to another applicant.
- We must receive the following information via email (preferred), mail or fax by April 1st of the current year in order for your application to be complete.**

 - 2 LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION** from people familiar with your 4-H work (preferably one from your county agent).
